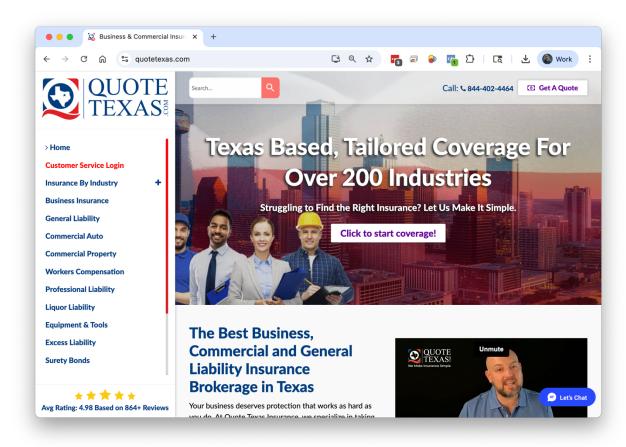
How to Add a Certificate Holder & Print Your Certificate of Insurance

This guide will help you add a certificate holder and print your Certificate of Insurance on the QuoteTexas.com website.

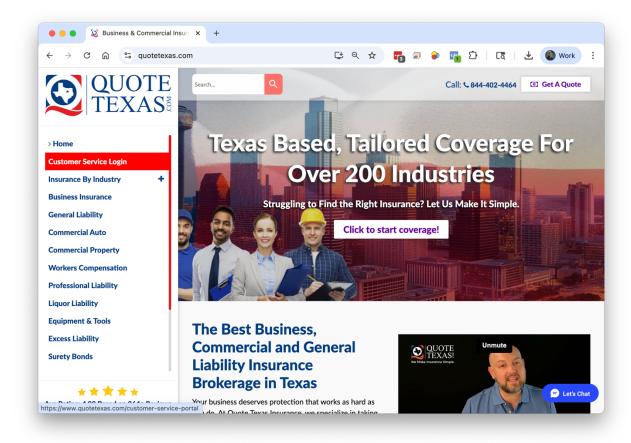
Steps to Add a Certificate Holder and Print Your Certificate

Step 1: Go to the QuoteTexas.com Website



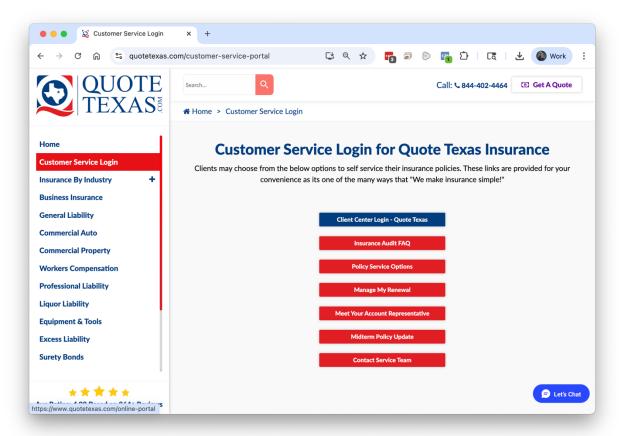
- Open your web browser (like Chrome or Edge).
- In the address bar, type the QuoteTexas.com website address.
- Press Enter on your keyboard.

Step 2: Find Customer Service Login



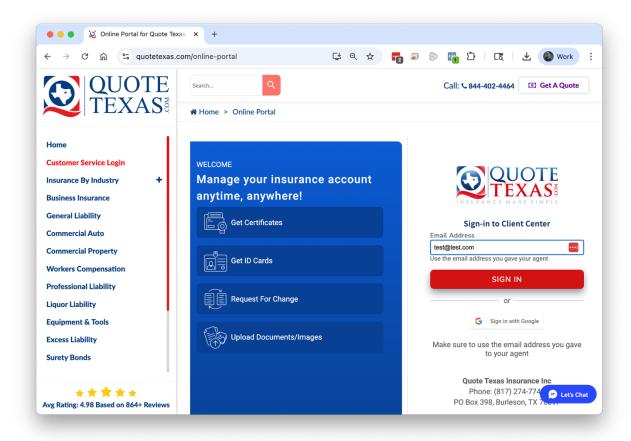
• Look for a button or link that says "Customer Service Login."

Click this button. It will take you to the Customer Service page.



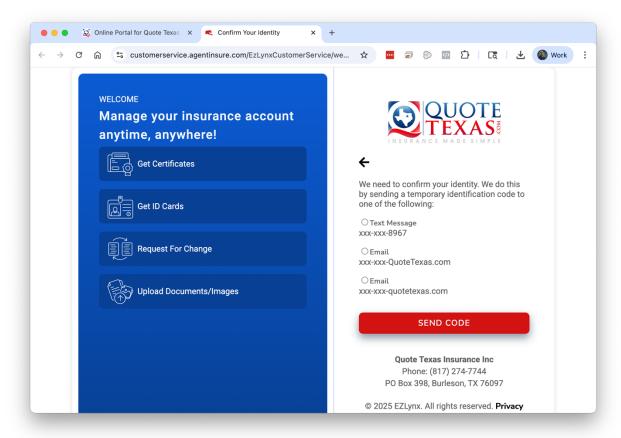
Find and click "Client Center Login."

Step 3: Log Into Your Account

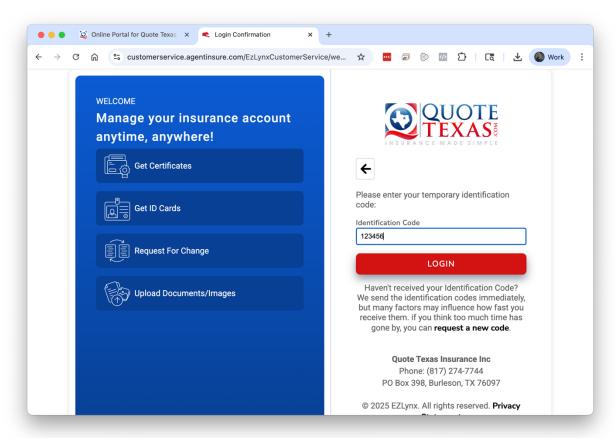


- You will see a space to enter your email address.
- Type your email address in the box.
- Click "Sign In."

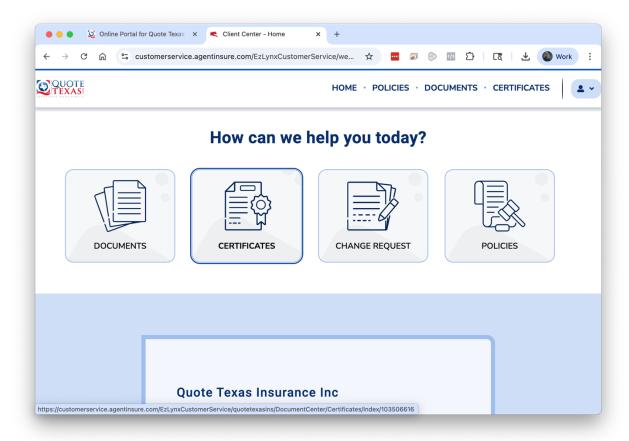
• You will now need to confirm your identity by sending a code to your email or phone.



• Input the code in the Identification Code box and click LOGIN.

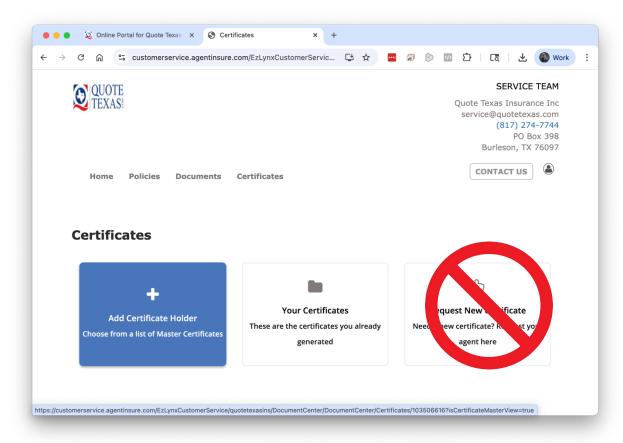


Step 4: Go to Certificates



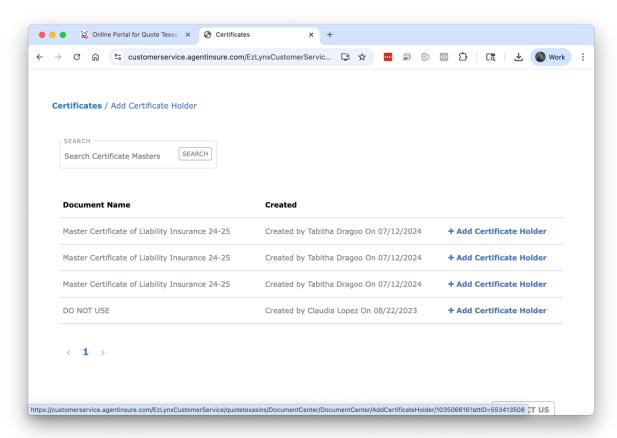
- Look for the "Certificates" icon or button on your dashboard.
- Click the "Certificates" icon.

Step 5: Start Adding a Certificate Holder

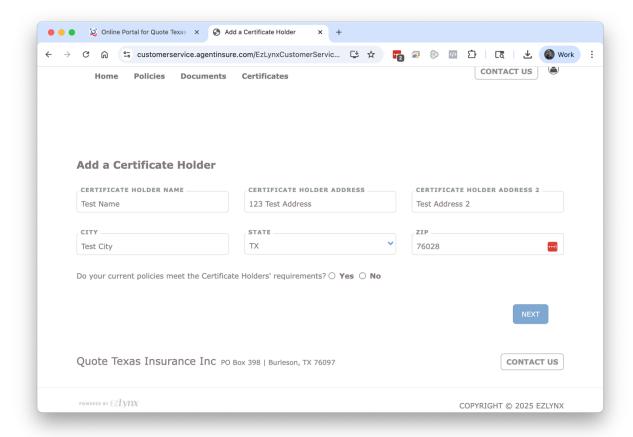


- Click the "Add Certificate Holder" button.
- A list with your master certificate(s) will appear.
- Find your newest master certificate.

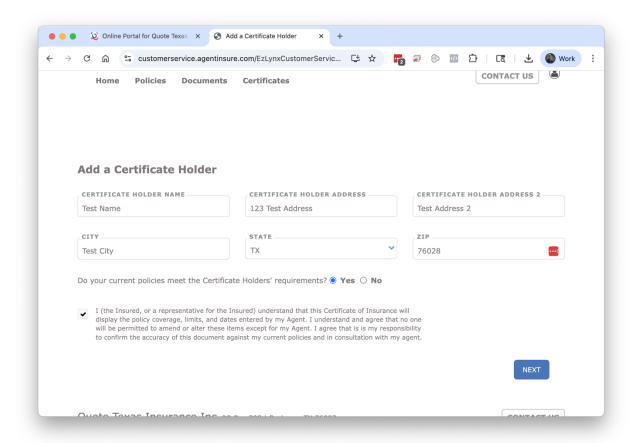
Click the "+ Add Certificate Holder" option next to your master certificate.



Step 6: Enter Certificate Holder Details

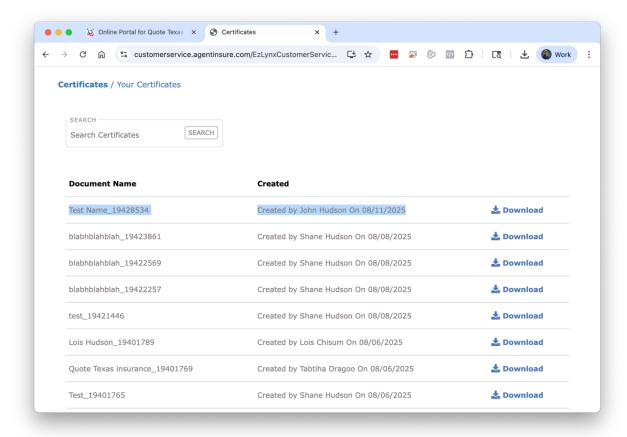


- You will see empty boxes for the certificate holder's information.
- Type the name of the person or company.
- Type their address (street, city, state, zip).
- Make sure your current policies meet the Certificate Holders requirements. If unsure, contact us at 817-274-7744
- Agree to the TERMS by clicking the box



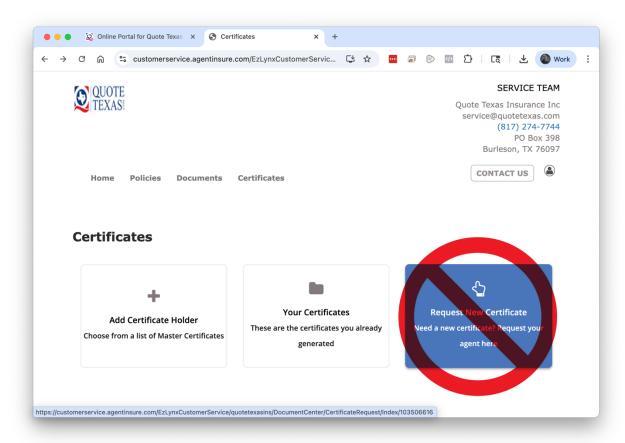
Click "Next."

Step 7: Download Your Certificate



- After clicking "Next," you will see the download option.
- Click the "Download" button.
- Your Certificate of Insurance will open or save to your computer.
- You can print this document if you want.

1. Important Note



- Do NOT click "Request New Certificate" unless you really need a special certificate or policy changes.
- This option is for custom certificates (for special requests).
- If you click "Request New Certificate," your request will be sent to the service team for manual review. This might take longer.

2. Tips and Troubleshooting

- If you don't get your code, try selecting the email or phone you did not first try.
- Check your email for any updates from QuoteTexas.com after you add a certificate holder.
- If you have trouble, call or email Quote Texas Insurance Customer Service for help.

3. Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What if I cannot find the Certificates icon?

A: Make sure you are logged into the Customer Center. Look for similar words like "Certificates" or "Documents."

• Q: What if the download does not work?

A: Check your browser for pop-up blockers. Try another browser if needed.

• Q: Can I add more than one certificate holder?

A: Yes. Repeat steps 5 and 6 for each person or company.

• Q: What if I made a mistake on the certificate?

A: Contact Quote Texas Insurance Customer Service to fix it.

4. Summary of Steps

- Go to the QuoteTexas website.
- Find Customer Service Login.
- Log in with your email.
- Click on Certificates.
- Add Certificate Holder and fill in the details.
- Download and print your certificate.
- Do NOT click "Request New Certificate" unless you need a custom one.
